## How to Measure

Always use a metal tape measure for accuracy and double check your measurements.

## Width

Measure the width of your existing track. If you don't have a track, measure the window frame width and allow enough space at each side for the curtains to clear the window, we recommend 15 cm each side. For example if the window is 130 cm wide add 40 cm ( 20 cm each side) to give a track width of 170 cm .

## Drop (Length)

Measure from the top of the curtain track to where you want your curtain to finish. If you don't have an existing track then measure from the top edge of the window frame to the lower edge of the window frame. You will then need to choose from our readymade drops of $160 \mathrm{~cm}, 205 \mathrm{~cm}, 220 \mathrm{~cm}$ or 240 cm and install your track accordingly. Where possible we recommend installing your track at least 10 cm above the window frame.
